### Two PhD scholarships under the Building Stronger Universities initiative

**Study Subject (s):** Fellowship is awarded for a research projects in the areas of Environmental Public Health (EPH) and Marine Coastal Ecosystem Health and Services (MaCES).

**Course Level:** PhD

**Scholarship Provider:** Danida is co-funding the participating universities which are the State University of Zanzibar and the University of Copenhagen, Denmark.

**Scholarship can be taken at:** Denmark East and Southern African countries subject to project terms.

**Eligibility:** Only applications from candidates that fulfil below criteria will be considered:-

- An MSc/ /MPhil degree has been completed at the time of application.
- Candidate must be below 40 years of age at time of application.
- Candidate must be a staff member of the State University of Zanzibar.
- Candidate must not already be registered as PhD candidate at any University.
- Candidate should propose an area relevant to the aspiration of the goals of the Project.
- The SUZA academic policies apply and each candidate will have to sign the contract for ensuring further services to SUZA after completion of the study.

**Scholarship Description:** Building Stronger Universities (BSU) is a partnership between research and higher education institutions in developing countries and Danish universities. The overall objective of the BSU initiative is to strengthen universities in developing countries to increasingly play a role in the economic, social and political development of the societies in which they are located.
