Preamble

The State University of Zanzibar (SUZA) under its mission of offering quality and broadly relevant education and research in order to develop a knowledge-based society that can tackle the challenge of 21st century and beyond invites eligible candidates who wish to pursue various programmes that are available at SUZA for the academic year 2018/2019.

Programmes to be offered by Schools situated at Tunguu, Vuga, Nkrumah, Mbwani, Chwaka, Maruhubi and Mchangomdogo - Pemba Campuses are as follows:

1. CATEGORY OF APPLICANTS

It is advised to all expected applicants that they read and understand the following Minimum Admission Entry Qualifications for 2018/2019 Admission Cycle

1. Students who have completed A-Level studies before 2014 qualify with two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points from two subjects defining the admission into the respective programme (where A=5; B=4; C=3; D=2; E=1). This criterion also falls to all students who completed A-Level studies from 2016 to date.
2. Students who have completed A-Level studies in 2014 and 2015 qualify with two principal passes (Two Cs) with a total of 4.0 points from Two subjects defining the admission into the respective programme (where A=5; B+ = 4; B = 3; C=2; D=1)
3. Students who are recognized for Prior Learning qualifications qualify with B+ Grade: where A=75-100, B+ = 65-74, B = 50-64, C= 40-49, D =35-39.
4. Students who apply for equivalent qualifications should have at least four O- Level passes (Ds and above) or NVA Level III with less than four O'-Level passes or equivalent foreign qualifications as established by either NECTA or VETA

AND

- i. At least a GPA of 3.0 for Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6

OR

- ii. Average of C for Full Technician Certificate (FTC) where A=5, B=4, C=3, and D=2 points.
OR
- iii. Average of 'B' Grade for Diploma in Teacher Education.
OR
- iv. Average of 'B' Grade for Health-related awards such as Clinical Medicine and others.
OR
- v. A distinction for unclassified diplomas and certificates.
OR
- vi. Upper Second Class for classified non-NTA diplomas.

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2.2 DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2.2.2 UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

2.2.2.1 BACHELOR OF ARTS WITH EDUCATION (BAE) - 3 YEARS

Entry Requirements

The applicant should possess:

- i) Five passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent, three of which should be at credit level (C) in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- ii) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes in appropriate subjects of not less than 4.0 points **excluding Religious studies** (those with higher scores will be given priority).

OR

- iii) Four passes (D) at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- iv) Holders of appropriate and recognized Diplomas of not less than Second Class (GPA of **3.0**) or above.

2.2.2.2 BACHELOR OF ARTS IN HISTORY AND ARCHEOLOGY (BAHA) - 3 YEARS

2.2.2.3 BACHELOR OF ARTS IN GEOGRAPHY AND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES (BAGES) - 3 YEARS

Entry Requirements

The applicant should possess:

- i) Five passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent, three of which should be at credit level (C) in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- ii) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes in appropriate subjects of not less than 4.0 points **excluding Religious studies** (those with higher scores will be given priority). **Applicants for BAGES, Geography is compulsory, so is History for BAHA applicants.**

OR

- iii) Four passes (D) at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- iv) Holders of appropriate and recognized Diplomas of not less than Second Class (GPA of **3.0**) or above.

2.2.2.4 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE WITH EDUCATION (BScED) - 3 YEARS

Entry Requirements

- i) Five passes including relevant science subjects at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent, three of which should be at credit level ('C' is a minimum).

PLUS

- ii) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes in relevant science subjects of not less than 4.0 points.

OR

- iii) Four passes (D) at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- iv) Holders of recognized and relevant Diplomas of not less than Second Class level (**GPA3.0**) or above.

2.2.2.5 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN COMPUTER SCIENCE (BScCS) - 3 YEARS

Entry Requirements

- i) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) or its equivalent, with at least two (2) principal where one must be on Advanced Mathematics.

AND

- ii) Three credits ‘C’ in the Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) issued by the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent.

OR

- iii) Four passes (D) at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- iv) A relevant accredited Diploma (Information Technology or Computer Science) by recognized Institutions with GPA of not less than 3.0 with calculated GPA of Mathematics and Computing courses of not less than 3.0.

2.2.2.6 BACHELOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY APPLICATION AND MANAGEMENT - 3 YEARS

Entry Requirements

- i) Three credit passes (‘C’ is minimum) at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent. Provided that not merely comprised of Languages and/or religious subjects.

PLUS

- ii) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes provided that subject combination is not merely comprised of languages and/or religious subjects.

OR

- iii) Four passes (D) at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- iv) A Diploma in IT, Computer Science or other relevant accredited Diploma by recognized Institutions with a GPA of not less than 3.0.

3.2.2.1 BACHELOR OF ARTS WITH EDUCATION (BAE) Languages (Kiswahili, Arabic and English) Combinations - 3 YEARS

AND

3.2.2.2 BACHELOR OF KISWAHILI WITH EDUCATION (BAKE) 3 YEARS

Entry Requirements

- i) Five passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent, three of which should be at credit level (C) in relevant subjects.

PLUS

- ii) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes in appropriate subjects of not less than 4.0 points **excluding Religious studies** (those with higher scores will be given priority). **An applicant for BAKE Kiswahili is compulsory.**

OR

- iii) Four passes (D) at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent in relevant subjects

PLUS

- iv) Holders of appropriate and recognized Diplomas of not less than Second Class (GPA of **3.0**) or above.

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4.2 DETAILED DESCRIPTION

4.2.1 UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

4.2.1.1 DOCTOR OF MEDICINE (MD) - 5 YEARS

Entry Requirements

- i) Five passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent, three of which should be at credit level (C) in science subjects including Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics.

PLUS

- ii) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with three (3) principal passes in Physics, Chemistry and Biology with minimum entry of 8 Points based on the following scale: A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1, S = 0.5, F = 0. Whereby one must have at least C grade in chemistry and Biology and D grade in Physics. Preference will be given to applicants who have completed Advanced Secondary Education within the past 3 years with PCB combinations.

OR

- iii) Holders of Diploma in Clinical Medicine or relevant diploma with at least C grade in Chemistry, Biology and D grade in Physics at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE)

4.2.1.2 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH (BScEH) - 3 YEARS

Entry Requirements

- i) Three principal passes in Chemistry, Biology and either Physics or Mathematics or Nutrition or Geography or Agriculture with a minimum of 6 points. Whereby one must have at least C grade in Chemistry and at least D grade in Biology and E grade in Physics or Mathematics or Nutrition or Geography or Agriculture.

PLUS

- ii) Five passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or its equivalent, three of which should be at credit level ('C) in Science subjects.

OR

- iii) Holders of a recognized Diploma in Environmental Health Sciences or any other relevant Diplomas of not less than Upper Second Class (GPA 3.5) with at least C grade in Chemistry, Biology and D grade in Physics at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) . Applicants with working experience have more advantage.

Entry Requirements

- i) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes with a total of 4.0 points excluding Religious and Language subjects with exception of Kiswahili and English.
PLUS
- ii) A minimum of four passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA).
OR
- iii) Holders of appropriate and recognized Diplomas of not less than Second Class (GPA 3) in Ordinary Diploma in Procurement and Supply Management, Ordinary Diploma in Financial Administration – Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Information Technology with Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Procurement and Logistic Management, Ordinary Diploma in Logistics and Transport Management, Ordinary Diploma in Freight Clearing and Forwarding, Ordinary Diploma in Materials Management, Ordinary Diploma in Marketing, Ordinary Diploma in Business Administration, Ordinary Diploma in Accountancy, Ordinary Diploma in Financial Administration, Ordinary Diploma in Banking and Finance, Ordinary Diploma in Local Government Accounting and Finance, Ordinary Diploma in Public Sector Finance Management obtained from an Institution recognized or accredited by the regulatory councils and which is relevant to the anticipated degree studies.

Entry Requirements

- i) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes with a total of 4.0 points excluding Religious and Language subjects with exception of Kiswahili and English.
PLUS
- ii) A minimum of four passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA).
OR
- iii) Holders of appropriate and recognized Diplomas of not less than Second Class (GPA 3.0) Ordinary Diploma in Procurement and Supply Management, Ordinary Diploma in Financial Administration – Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Information

Technology with Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Procurement and Logistic Management, Ordinary Diploma in Logistics and Transport Management, Ordinary Diploma in Freight Clearing and Forwarding, Ordinary Diploma in Materials Management, Ordinary Diploma in Marketing, Ordinary Diploma in Business Administration, Ordinary Diploma in Accountancy, Ordinary Diploma in Financial Administration, Ordinary Diploma in Banking And Finance, Ordinary Diploma in Local Government Accounting and Finance, Ordinary Diploma in Public Sector Finance Management, obtained from an Institution recognized or accredited by the regulatory councils and which is relevant to the anticipated degree studies.

Entry Requirements

- i) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes with a total of 4.0 points excluding Religious and Language subjects with exception of Kiswahili and English.
PLUS
- ii) A minimum of four passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA).
OR
- iii) Holders of appropriate and recognized Diplomas of not less than Second Class (GPA 3.0) Ordinary Diploma in Procurement and Supply Management, Ordinary Diploma in Financial Administration – Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Information Technology with Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Procurement and Logistic Management, Ordinary Diploma in Logistics and Transport Management, Ordinary Diploma in Freight Clearing and Forwarding, Ordinary Diploma in Materials Management, Ordinary Diploma in Marketing, Ordinary Diploma in Business Administration, Ordinary Diploma in Accountancy, Ordinary Diploma in Financial Administration, Ordinary Diploma in Banking and Finance, Ordinary Diploma in Local Government Accounting and Finance, Ordinary Diploma in Public Sector Finance Management, obtained from an Institution recognized or accredited by the regulatory councils and which is relevant to the anticipated degree studies.

Entry Requirements

- i) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least two (2) Principal passes with a total of 4.0 points excluding Religious and Language subjects with exception of Kiswahili and English.
- ii) A minimum of four passes at Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA).
- iii) Holders of appropriate and recognized Diploma of not less than Second Class (GPA 3) Ordinary Diploma in Information Technology with Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Business with Information Technology, Ordinary Diploma in Financial Administration – Accounting, Ordinary Diploma in Information Technology,

Ordinary Diploma in Computing and Information Technology, Ordinary Diploma In Information and Communication Technology, Ordinary Diploma in Electronics and Telecommunications with Computer Engineering, Ordinary Diploma in Computer Engineering, Ordinary Diploma in Computer Science and Engineering, Ordinary Diploma in Computer Science, Ordinary Diploma in Computer Applications, Ordinary Diploma in Electronics and Telecommunications with Industrial Automation, Ordinary Diploma in Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering obtained from an Institution recognized or accredited by the regulatory councils and which is relevant to the anticipated degree studies.

- Passes in 'Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination are based in the following scales:-

(Before 2014 Certificates and 2016 to date)

A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1, S = 0.5, F = 0

(For 2014 and 2015).

A = 5, B+ = 4, B = 3, C = 2, D = 1, E = 0.5, F = 0

- All Bachelor degree programmes cover three years (6 semesters) except Doctor of Science in Medicine which covers five years (10 semesters).
- Diploma programmes of two years cover four semesters while Diploma programmes of three years cover six semesters.

MODE OF APPLICATION

The applicants are requested to fill in the application forms through online admission (follow the link - <http://osim.suza.ac.tz> or www.suza.ac.tz/onlineadmission); they have to follow all steps clearly for accurate filling in. It is highly insisted to read the admission guidelines properly before filling in the form and fill in the form accurately.

The application fee for all undergraduate, diploma and certificate programmes is a **nonrefundable fee of Tsh. 10,000.**

CLOSING DATES

The closing dates for applications are scheduled as follows:

- (1) 15th August, 2018 for applicants who have completed form six and diploma in previous years (Batch 1)
- (2) 7th September, 2018 for applicants who have completed form six and diploma in 2018 (Batch 2).
- (3) There are also closing dates for specific programmes as indicated in the table below, after which the unsuccessful applicants may opt to apply for another programme. The second application for unsuccessful applicants shall not be charged. It is further advised to observe the closing dates accurately and make a proper three - course choice.
