## ADMISSION TO MASTERS AND PhD PROGRAMMES OFFERED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF ZANZIBAR FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019/2020

### Preamble

The State University of Zanzibar (SUZA) under its mission of offering quality and broadly relevant education and research in order to develop a knowledge-based society that can tackle the challenge of 21<sup>st</sup> century and beyond invites eligible candidates who wish to pursue graduate programmes that are available at SUZA for the academic year 2019/2020.

### MASTERS OF SCIENCE IN CHEMISTRY (MScCh) by Coursework and Dissertation - 2 years

#### Entry Requirements

- i) Applicants must be graduates in Bachelor of Science (majoring Chemistry) and attain at least a GPA of 2.7 (**B**) or above from SUZA or any other recognized higher learning institution.
- ii) Candidates with Pass degrees may also be considered for admission if their undergraduate performance in Chemistry was a '**B**' grade or above.
- iii) Candidates who hold unclassified degrees should have an average credit of '**B**' or above

### MASTERS OF SCIENCE IN ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE (MScESc) by thesis - 2 years

A candidate for admission into a Masters degree shall hold:

- i) At least a second class Bachelors degree from SUZA or any other recognized higher learning institution majoring Science or Geography;
- ii) A candidate who holds an unclassified degree should have an average credit of 'B' or above.
- iii) An applicant from a local university who is in the final semester of his/her undergraduate study programme may be considered for provisional admission provided that his/her current GPA or equivalent qualification satisfies the graduate programme admission requirements.

**MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT AND CLIMATE CHANGE (MSC. NRM & CC) By Coursework and Dissertation - 2 years**

The entry requirements for this programme have been described in “Graduate Studies Regulations, 2013” of the State University of Zanzibar. For any applicant to be considered for enrollment into the programme shall be a holder of relevant bachelor degree from the State University of Zanzibar or an equivalent degree from other recognized universities covering any of the subjects of Natural resources, Chemistry, Biology, Geography and any other relevant environmental related disciplines with at least a GPA of 2.8.

**MASTER OF EDUCATION IN TEACHING OF KISWAHILI TO SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGES (TEKSOL) M Ed TEKSOL by Coursework and Dissertation - 2 years**

**Entry Requirement**

A candidate for admission into this Masters Degree programme from any recognised institution shall hold the following qualifications:

- a) At least Upper Second Class degree with Kiswahili language specialization or an equivalent Bachelor degree from a recognized institution of higher learning.

**OR**

- b) Candidates with Bachelor degree at lower second class honours level where education/language was taken as a major or minor option or has a postgraduate diploma in the proposed field of study.

**OR**

- c) Candidates with pass degrees may also be considered for admission if:

Their undergraduate performance in the proposed subject of study was a B grade or higher;  
They have satisfied the relevant College/School/Institute regarding their academic potential through subsequent research experience and/or additional training.

**MASTER OF EDUCATION IN YOUTH, GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (M ED Y&G) By Coursework and Dissertation - 2 years**

**Entry Requirements**

A candidate for admission into this Master’s degree programme of the recognized university shall hold the following qualifications:

At least a Second Class degree or an equivalent degree from a recognized institution of higher learning. Candidates who hold unclassified degrees should have at least a B grade average in the subject of the intended Masters study.

**OR**

Candidates with Bachelor degree at lower second class honors level where education was taken as a major or minor option or has a postgraduate diploma in education.

**OR**

Candidates with pass degrees may also be considered for admission if:

Their undergraduate performance in the proposed subject of study was a B grade or higher;

They have satisfied the relevant College/School/Institute regarding their academic potential through subsequent research experience and/or additional training.

NB: Preference will be given to such students with education, youth and gender specializations background.

### **SHAHADA YA UZAMILI YA KISWAHILI (MASTERS OF ART IN KISWAHILI LANGUAGE) (MA Kiswahili)**

#### **1 Usajili na Udahili**

- i) Mwombaji awe na shahada ya pili yenye WAKIA ya kuanzia 3.0 kwa ujumla na WAKIA wa walau 2.8 katika somo la Kiswahili au sifa za uwiano kama inayoonekana inafaa
- ii) Mwombaji awe amesoma Kiswahili katika Shahada ya Pili.

The applicants are requested to fill in the application forms through online admission (follow the link - <https://www.suza.ac.tz/notice/admission-to-masters-and-phd-programmes/>); they have to follow all steps clearly for accurate filling in. It is highly insisted to read the admission guidelines properly before filling in the forms and fill in accurately.

The application fee for any of the program is **a non-refundable fee of TZS. 30,000/-**
