The State University of Zanzibar (SUZA) is the only Public University in Zanzibar established by Act No. 8 of the House of Representatives of 1999 which was amended by Act No. 11 of 2009, and further re-amended by Act No. 7 of 2016, Act No 1 Part 4 of 2019 and Act No. 13 of 2020. Since its inception in 2002, SUZA has been expanding in academic programs as well as student enrolment. Its vision is to be the most preferred University in the Eastern Africa.

- Holder of a Master Degree with at least a GPA of 4.0 out of 5 and the First Degree with a minimum GPA of 3.5 out of 5 in the relevant field.
- Prior experience in teaching at University level is an added advantage.

iii. Tutorial Assistant

- Holder of First Degree with a minimum GPA of 3.5 out of 5 in the relevant field.

9. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A Tutorial Assistant is expected to:

- I. Conduct tutorial/seminars and practical;
- II. Assist in research, consultancy and outreach activities;
- III. Understudy senior members, including attending lectures, seminars, tutorials and practical training; and
- IV. Perform any other relevant duties assigned by relevant authorities.

An Assistant Lecturer is expected to:

- i. Carry out lectures, conduct tutorials, seminars and practical for Undergraduate programs;
- ii. Prepare and present case studies;
- iii. Conduct and publish/disseminate research results;
- iv. Participate in consultancies and community services under supervision;
- v. Attend workshops, conferences and symposia; and
- vi. Perform any other relevant duties and responsibilities that may be assigned by relevant authorities.

A Lecturer is expected to:

- I. Carry out lectures, conduct tutorials, seminars and practical, invigilation and assessment for undergraduate and postgraduate programs;
- II. Conduct research and publish in the areas of specialization;
- III. Carry out consultancies and community services;
- IV. Conduct and publish/disseminate research results;
- V. Write teaching manuals and compendia;
- VI. Attend/organize workshops, conferences and symposia;
- VII. Mentor junior staff in relevant fields;
- VIII. Supervise field practical, undergraduate special projects, Master's and PhD dissertations/theses; and
- IX. Perform any other relevant duties and responsibilities that may be assigned by relevant authorities.

- Applicants must attach copies of relevant academic certificates, Zan ID, current curriculum vitae, letters of recommendation from two (2) outstanding academic/work referees and indicate reliable contacts.
- Age limit for Applicants who are not public servants:
 - i. Tutorial Assistant/Assistant Lecturer - 40 years of age;
 - ii. Lecturer 45 years of age.
- Applicants under Public service employment **MUST** forward their application letters through their respective employers. Failure to do that, their applications will not be considered.
- Certificates from Foreign Examination Bodies for Ordinary or Advanced Level Education should be verified by the National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA) and for Technical Education should be verified by the National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET).
